

EMERGENCY TRAILERING

Another aspect of equine emergency preparedness is access to a trailer to transport a seriously ill patient. As you may know, we maintain a fleet of four ambulatory units with which we treat a variety of emergencies in the field. However, there are a number of serious problems which are treated more appropriately in a hospital setting. Examples would be severe colic, major lacerations, and very ill horses requiring extensive diagnostics and intensive care. The clinic can provide a controlled environment, excellent lighting, support staff, diagnostics including laboratory, and intensive care housing.

If you do not own a horse trailer and suitable towing vehicle, it is advisable to advance planning for transportation of a severe emergency. This might include arrangements with friends or neighbors or knowledge of available rental trailers or professional haulers. We have listed below rental agencies (trailers only) and professional haulers from the general area.
