

## **Save Money on Vaccines by Scheduling a Clinic**

January, February, and March are the ideal time to get your horses' winter/spring vaccines. We recommend that the first West Nile vaccine of the year be done soon so that a 6 month booster can be done along with the Flu/Rhino booster at the beginning of the period in which we see most West Nile cases (July-October).

Clients will receive a 15% discount on vaccines given to a group of 6 or more horses. The veterinarian at these clinics will also be available to do oral exams, sheath cleaning, and consultation on other horse care issues. Based on the outcome of the oral exams, full dentals may be done as time allows. Dentals will also be part of the special 15% discount.

Appointments for vaccine clinics should be made with our front office. It will be of great assistance in the planning process to fill out a clinic vaccination form. We will need the patient's names and type of vaccines, the number of sheath cleanings, and the likely number of dentals. If there are multiple owners involved, their names should also be supplied, so we can bring appropriate medical records. Clients should be prepared to pay at time of service to receive the discount. The front office can mail or fax this form.

For clients with fewer than 6 horses to vaccinate, we will offer a 15% discount on your Fall Flu/Rhino and West Nile vaccines if we have given the Spring Vaccines to your horses. Please remind the front office when scheduling your Fall vaccines that our clinic also did your Spring vaccines.
